Re: Application of parking permits for Millfields Road residents

Dear resident,

As you may be aware, Parking Services recently consulted residents in Sewdley Street, Chippendale Street and the northern section of Glyn Road about the proposed introduction of parking controls, by extending Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) N (Homerton).

The consultation took place in response to a petition received from affected residents asking for parking controls to be introduced.

During the consultation, we also received feedback from residents in Millfields Road expressing concerns with the extension of the CPZ; including increased demand for the limited parking space in Millfields Road and the loss of alternative parking spaces in Sewdley and Chippendale Streets.

The aim of this letter is to provide you with an update on the results of the consultation and how the CPZ extension will affect you.

It also provides information about what measures the Council will take to reduce the impact of the CPZ extension on Millfields Road residents.

Consultation Results

Parking Services has approved the introduction of parking controls in Sewdley Street and Chippendale Street based on majority support from local residents. While an equal response was received from Glyn Road respondents, the northern section of Glyn Road will also be included to create a logical CPZ boundary and to reduce confusion for motorists.

Parking Permits for Millfields Road residents

To reduce the impact of the upcoming extension of the CPZ, we will be allowing residents in Millfields Road (nos. 172 – 226 only) to apply for a Zone N parking permit.

At this stage we do not have plans to consult on the installation of parking controls in Millfields Road itself. However, we will monitor the situation closely over the next few months and will consult with local residents where a need is shown.

Applying for parking permits

If you live or work in Millfields Road you may wish to apply for a parking permit to park in Zone N. The operational hours of the CPZ are: **Monday to Friday 7:30am – 6:30pm**. Outside these hours you would not need to display a permit; however some other restrictions such as double yellow lines and disabled parking bays will be enforceable 24 hours.

From **6th September** you may begin to purchase a Zone N permit.

When making your application please remember to bring all supporting documents such as proof of identification, address and vehicle ownership. Further details can be found on the application form.

Please note that Zone N parking permit will allow you to park in any street within the parking zone.

How much does a permit cost?

Visitor vouchers

Visitor vouchers can be purchased which will allow your visitors to park in any vacant 'resident', 'general permit' or 'shared use' (pay and display and permit) bay in the CPZ. You only need to use a visitor voucher during the operational hours of the zone.

Each voucher allows half a day's parking but two can be displayed together to park for a longer period. They are available in books of 10, which cost £9.30, and concessions are available.

What if I use a motorcycle?

Motorcycles can be parked in a CPZ free of charge and in any bay, as long as the motorcycle is parked at a right angle to the kerb. You should use the dedicated motorcycle bays where possible rather than resident bays and always park at the end of the bay.

When will works start?

Lining works

In **September 2010**, we plan to start installing the parking bays and yellow lines in the affected streets.

When lining works are being carried out, it will be necessary to put in place road closures to allow works to take place. We will write to all residents closer to the time and will place warning notices on the street to provide lining dates and ensure that vehicles are not parked at these locations when works are being carried out.

We have also taken into consideration your comments on the design of the parking layout as part of the consultation and will be installing the parking controls shown in the enclosed map.

Parking enforcement

We plan to begin enforcement of the parking restrictions in your street on: **4th October 2010**. From this date, all motorists will need to display a Zone N parking permit, visitor voucher or pay and display ticket during the operational hours of the CPZ.
