**Re: Consultation results on the proposed introduction of parking controls**

Dear resident,

Between May and July 2010, Parking Services consulted all residents in Sewdley Street, Chippendale Street and the northern section of Glyn Road about the proposed introduction of parking controls, by extending Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) N (Homerton).

During the consultation, we also asked for your views on the proposed design of the parking restrictions that would be introduced if supported by the majority of people who return their questionnaires.

We would firstly like to thank all those people who returned their questionnaire, attended our public drop in session, or contacted the Council throughout the public consultation. Your feedback has played a vital part in the changes that are about to be made.

This letter provides a summary of the consultation results and the Council's final decision on the introduction of parking controls in your road. It also explains what you will need to do to park under the new arrangements and when the changes are likely to take place.

## Consultation results

Overall, 49% of people returned their questionnaire or provided feedback during the consultation.

Of those people who returned their questionnaire, 69% supported the proposed introduction of parking controls.

At an individual road level, both Chippendale (57%) and Sewdley Street (92%) respondents were strongly in favour while those people from Glyn Road were equally divided in opinion (50%).

## Council's decision

As a result of majority support from local residents, the Council approves the introduction of parking controls in the affected streets. While support received from Glyn Road respondents was equally split, a decision was made to also include this section to create a logical CPZ boundary and to reduce confusion for motorists. With the introduction of controls in Sewdley Street and Chippendale Street, levels of parking demand would also significantly increase in Glyn Road as local drivers seek alternative free parking spaces.

We have also received substantial feedback from residents in Millfields Road concerned about the potential impact of displacement parking. As such we have amended the Zone boundary to allow a section of Millfields Road residents to purchase a parking permit.

## What happens next?

### **Traffic Management Orders (TMOs)**

Before we incorporate the roads into the CPZ, we are required to advertise the Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) in the Hackney Today newspaper. This will ensure that the parking restrictions on your street can be legally enforced. The 'proposed' TMO notice will be advertised on the 9<sup>th</sup> August 2010. This provides a statutory 21 day period for people to have their say on the changes. We then plan to advertise the 'made' notice on the 13<sup>th</sup> September 2010 which informs the public that we are going ahead with the changes.

## Lining works

In **September 2010**, we will start installing the parking bays and yellow lines in your street as well as the posts and parking bay signage.

When lining works are being carried out, Parking Services are required to put in place road closures to allow works to take place. We will write to all residents closer to the time and will place warning notices on the street to provide lining dates and ensure that vehicles are not parked at these locations when works are being carried out.

We have also taken into consideration your comments on the design of the parking layout as part of the consultation and will be installing the parking controls shown in the enclosed map.

## Parking enforcement

We plan to begin enforcement of the parking restrictions in your street on: **4<sup>th</sup> October 2010**. From this date, all motorists will need to display a Zone N parking permit, visitor voucher or pay and display ticket during the operational hours of the CPZ.

### Applying for parking permits

If you live or work in the affected streets you will soon need a parking permit to park in your street during the operational hours of the CPZ: **Monday to Friday 7:30am – 6:30pm**. Outside these hours you do not need to display a permit; however some other restrictions such as double yellow lines and disabled parking bays will be enforceable 24 hours.

From **6<sup>th</sup> September 2010** you may begin to purchase a Zone N permit.

When making your application please remember to bring all supporting documents such as proof of identification, address and vehicle ownership. Further details can be found on the application form.

Please note that Zone N parking permit will allow you to park in any street within the parking zone.

## How much does a permit cost?

## Visitor vouchers

Visitor vouchers can be purchased which will allow your visitors to park in any vacant 'resident', 'general permit' or 'shared use' (pay and display and permit) bay in the CPZ. You only need to use a visitor voucher during the operational hours of the zone.

Each voucher allows half a day's parking but two can be displayed together to park for a longer period. They are available in books of 10, which cost £9.30, and concessions are available.

## What if I use a motorcycle?

Motorcycles can be parked in a CPZ free of charge and in any bay, as long as the motorcycle is parked at a right angle to the kerb. You should use the dedicated motorcycle bays where possible rather than resident bays and always park at the end of the bay.
