Mid-late C18 terrace of large proportions, each house 4 storeys and basement,  
3 windows. Brown brick with red brick dressings and stone coped parapet. Gauged  
flat brick arches to sash windows, some retaining glazing bars. 1st floor winddows  
of No 57 altered to long casements and an iron-railed balcony added, resting at  
right on Doric porch with fluted columns. Ground floor of No 57 faced with banded  
rusticated stucco, but otherwise basements only stuccoed. 66 -panel doors (No 55  
half-glazed) in deep reveals (No 61 panelled). No 47 has cornice head continuing  
to form impost blocks of narrow moulded architrave over fanlight: and prostyle  
Ionic porch with enriched frieze and cornice. Nos 51 and 53 have Roman Doric doorcases  
with open pediments above fanlights: Nos 59 and 61 have open pedimented doorcases,  
the latter with mutules to cornice and pediment .
