1808 building of 3 storeys and attic, 2-window front and 3-bay left return, with octagonal tower under copper dome on angle. Strapwork frieze below dome carries date. Red brick with Portland stone dressings. 3 gables interspersed by parapet. Bands at window heads on all floors. Stone-mullioned windows, some with transoms. Black and red granite ground floor has bays divided by pilasters with leafy capitals. Original engraved glass showing a plough among leafy ornament. Heavy cornice above ground floor fascia. In lobby decorative glazed tiles showing ploughman and his team.
