1825 by D R Roper, originally the Haberdashers' Almshouses. 2 storeys attic and basement. Central projecting tetrastyle portico with pediment, wreaths in frieze and fluted Doric columns. Central entrance doors in moulded architrave. At either side a 4-window section and a 1-window projecting end wing. Slated mansard roof with round-headed dormers. Yellow stock brick with stone frieze, cornice and parapet. Sash windows with glazing bars in stucco-lined reveals, those on ground floor of wings tripartite, Moulded stone architraves to ground floor windows and to doors in outer bays of link sections. 5 steps to stylobate of portico have side walls carrying iron lampholders. Low stone piers support modern area railings.
