1878-9 by Ewan Christian. A tall town church on a narrow site influenced by James Brooks' neighbouring churches. Red brick with high pitched slated roof, and some stone dressings, lancet style. Nave with tall clerestory and low, blank aisles. Wide central tower, above chancel, has very steeply-pitched, near-pyramidal roof and north-east staircase turret with conical roof. Short, lower sanctuary and short gabled transepts, the south one altered after fire damage. Interior now whitewashed. 3-bay nave with very wide arches resting on plain round piers, all but one with waterleaf capitals. Rib vaulted crossing and sanctuary roofs. Crown-post timber roof to nave. Glass in east window by A F Erridge. At west end Calvary screen from the Church of St Philip the Apostle, Dalston (1841) destroyed by bombing in 1940.
