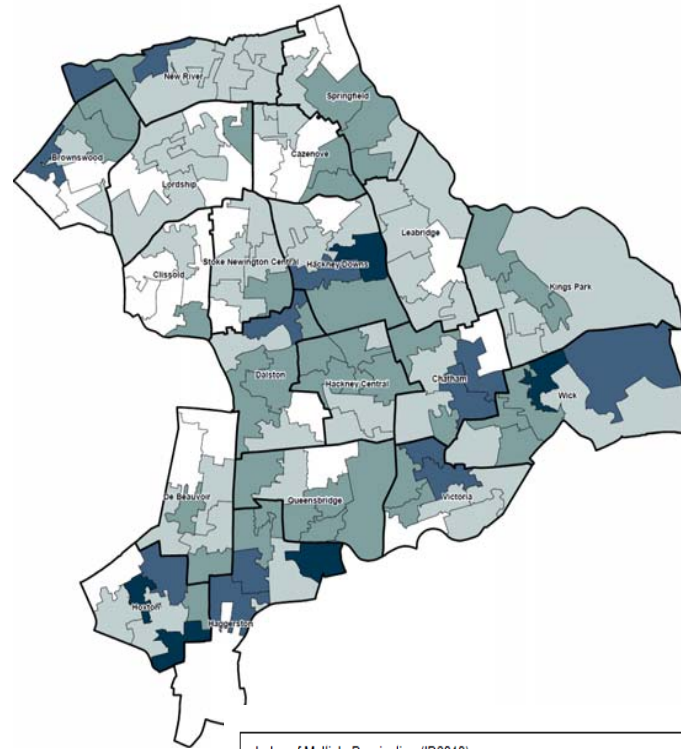

Index of Multiple Deprivation (ID2010)

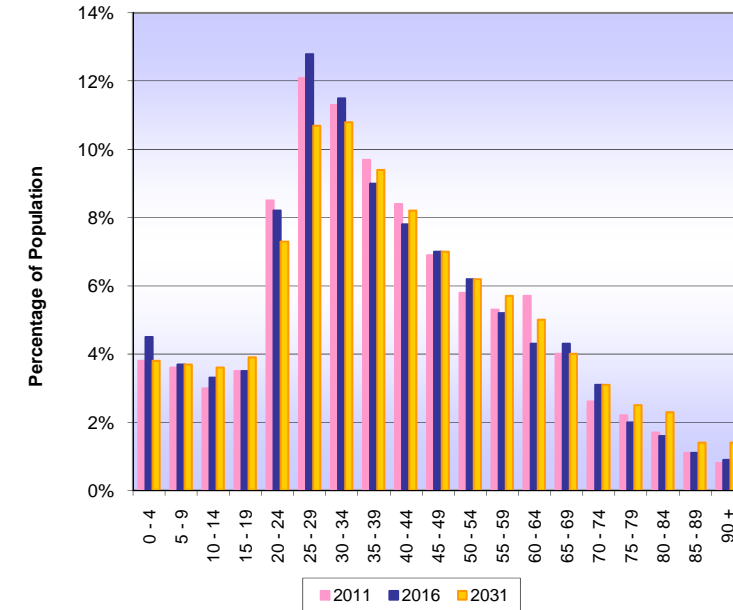

## Gender re-assignment

Data on gender re-assignment is not available at a borough level, but the NHS Choices website estimates that one in 4,000 people in the UK are undergoing treatment for gender dysphoria.

This equates to around 60 people in Hackney.

In 2007, ACAS estimated that there were 5,000 people living in the UK, who had undergone gender re-assignment surgery.
