Hackney Marshes and London 2012 – information for users

The London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games are now less than a year away and final plans for the successful staging of the world's largest event continue to develop. Undoubtedly, there will be some disruption to the usage of the Marshes and we are asking all users to be mindful of this.

The Council have asked GLL not to take any bookings for the facilities on the Marshes and Mabley Green from the 1 May to 30 September 2012 until we have confirmed our plans. The BBC Radio 1 Hackney Weekend 2012 has been announced for the weekend of 23/24 June 2012 and the Council and partners are still developing proposals for the use of the Marshes during Games time. We aim to be in a position to update you early in the New Year. In the meantime, the latest information will be found at www.hackney.gov.uk/2012-games.

Roads around Hackney Marshes will be heavily impacted by the Northern Transport Mall, which is identified as a road junction hotspot. There will also be impacts from the Olympic Route Network.

Venue, traffic and parking plans

London 2012, together with local authorities and key transport partners, is developing plans to manage traffic and parking around each of the Olympic venues. These plans may include temporary parking controls on event days, road closures and traffic changes at peak times. Residents and businesses will still be able to park near their properties. Arrangements will also be made to ensure everyday activities such as deliveries can continue. The plans are currently in development and we expect London 2012 to make them available at www.tfl.gov.uk/2012.

Further information

TFL is expected to release data to show anticipated queue times at each station on all Tube lines, the DLR, London Overground and at key National Rail stations on a line-by-line, day-by-day basis. We also expect them to release further 'hot spot' information about the road network across London. These will show expected additional travel times to other parts of the Capital from the individual hotspot locations. Please keep checking www.tfl.gov.uk/2012 for further information.
