

**LONDON BOROUGH OF HACKNEY**

**THE HACKNEY (FREE PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS)  
(AMENDMENT NO.1) ORDER 2008**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2008 the Council of the London Borough of Hackney made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6, and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce disabled parking bays into sections of the following roads: Adley Road, Ashmead House, Balance Road, Daubeney Road, Domfe Place, Elderfield Road, Evering Road, Glyn Road, Harrowgate Road, Ickburgh Road, Leadale Road, Lockhurst Street, Mayola Road, Morpeth Road, Osbaldeston Road, Portland Avenue, Reighton Road, Rushmore Road, St Andrews Grove, Sharon Gardens and Tryon Crescent.
3. Copies of the Order, which comes into force on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2008 and of other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the expiration of a period of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, in the reception area, 263 Mare Street, London Borough of Hackney, London, E8 3HT. 4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court
