**THE HACKNEY (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS)
(AMENDMENT NO.3) ORDER 2008**

TRO 340

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 11th April 2008 the Council of the London Borough of Hackney made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce “school keep clear” markings operating between 8am and 9.30am and between 2.30pm and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays during school term time into a certain section of Halcomb Street.
3. Copies of the Order, which comes into force 16th April 2008 and of other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the expiration of a period of six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, in the reception area, London Borough of Hackney, 263 Mare Street, London, E8 3HT, or on line at <http://www.hackney.gov.uk>. 4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
