The Council of the London Borough of Hackney, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on \* 200\* and may be cited as the Hackney (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. \*) Order 200\*.
2. In this Order "carriageway" has the same meaning as in the Highways Act 1980 (c)
3. (1) Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before coming into operation of this Order the Hackney (Prescribed Routes) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2007(d) shall have effect as though there were added to Schedule 6 of that Order the item included in the Schedule to this Order.  
  
(2) Provided that nothing in the Schedule to this Order shall apply in relation to any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade, or police purposes in an emergency, or pedal cyclists.
4. The prohibitions referred to in the Schedule to this Order will not apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, or anything done in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
