Hackney One Carnival returns for a second year as part of the Cultural Olympiad, celebrating arts and culture alongside sports in the run up to the 2012 Games.

Throughout this fun filled day, Hackney's world class Carnival groups will parade the streets and the whole community will come together as one to celebrate the cultures which make our borough so special.

The carnival route is passing through a street close to you (see route map overleaf) . The procession will travel this route for about two hours, as follows:

- Starting at Hackney Town Hall at 11.30am
- Northbound along Mare Street
- Left into Amhurst Road
- Right into Pembury Road
- Left into Hackney Downs Park.

We are expecting the procession to arrive at Hackney Downs Park at approx 12.30pm. From 12.30pm, Carnival groups will be showcasing their costumes on stage and will be joined by many other community arts based organisations

The fun in the park will include music and entertainment, sport and cultural activities, and a children's play area.

So why not get involved and be part of it! Follow the carnival procession and enjoy a fun filled afternoon at Hackney Downs Park!

Local residents please note: Reading Lane, Wilton Way and Hillman Street at the back of Hackney Town Hall will be closed from 8:00am until 1:00pm to allow the Carnival procession to gather.
