

## **HOMERTON ROW E9 – TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS**

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1) AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

**The Council of London Borough of Hackney HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the Construction of Education Buildings within HOMERTON ROAD E9, they intend to make an order the effect of which would be only at such times as regulatory traffic signs are displayed to: -**

1. Close the north eastern footpath along Chapman Road from a point in line with the north western kerbline of Wallis Road to a point approximately 75 metres north west of that intersection point.
2. Close the north western footpath along Wallis Road along its entire length between its junction with Chapman Road and its junction with Hepscott Road
3. The preferred diversion route will be the footpaths located on the opposite of the affected street
4. The restriction will not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the said works or used for fire brigade, ambulance, or purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the discretion of a Police Constable in uniform.
5. The restriction referred to in sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above will not apply so as to prevent vehicles gaining ingress to, or egress from the premises on or adjacent to the closed length of footpath in so far as such ingress or egress is reasonably practicable without undue interference with the execution of the said works.
6. The Order will come into operation on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2008 at 0800 hrs and remain in operation until 7<sup>th</sup> September 2009 at 1800 hrs or until the work has been completed whichever is sooner.
