

ABNEY GARDENS N16 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation act 1984 – section 14(1) as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) act 1991 and the Traffic Management act 2004

The Council of London Borough of Hackney HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to planned STREET LIGHTING WORKS within ABNEY GARDENS N16 they have made an order. The general effect of which will be only at such times and to such extent as regulatory traffic signs are displayed to: -

1. **Prohibition of driving**

Abney Gardens From its northern junction with Stoke Newington High Street (A10) along its entire length to a point approximately 7 metres east of its southern (closed) junction with Stoke Newington High Street (A10)

2. **Prohibition of waiting loading and unloading at any time**

Abney Gardens From its northern junction with Stoke Newington High Street (A10) along its entire length to a point approximately 7 metres east of its southern (closed) junction with Stoke Newington High Street (A10)

3. The restriction will not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the said works or used for fire brigade, ambulance, or purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the discretion of a Police Constable in uniform.

4. The restrictions referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2) above will not apply so as to prevent vehicles gaining ingress to, or egress from the premises on or adjacent to the closed length of road in so far as such ingress or egress is reasonably practicable without undue interference with the execution of the said works.

5. The Order will operate on and between the following dates and times or until the work has been completed whichever is sooner
