

**DIGBY RD, BERGER RD &
BARNABAS RD E9****TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING**

Road Traffic Regulation act 1984 – section 14(1) as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) act 1991 and the Traffic Management act 2004

The Council of London Borough of Hackney HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to planned ABNORMAL DELIVERIES within DIGBY ROAD, BERGER ROAD and BARNABAS ROAD they intend to make an order. The general effect of which will be only at such times and to such extent as regulatory traffic signs are displayed to: -

1. Prohibition of waiting loading and unloading**Monday, Wednesday & Thursday 0700 hrs – 1800hrs**

Barnabas Road west side	Between points 9 metres (m) and 24m north of its intersection with the northern kerb line of Oriol Road
Berger Road south side	Between points 13m (end of existing double yellow line) and 23m west of its intersection with Barnabas Road
Berger Road north west side	Between points 5m and 25m north east of its intersection with the north eastern kerb line of Digby Road
Berger Road south east side	From a point in line with the south western kerb line of Digby Road in a north easterly direction for 37m
Digby Road north east side	Between points 15m and 35m north west of its intersection with the north western kerb line of Berger Road
Digby Road south west side	From a point in line with the south eastern kerb line of Berger Road in a north westerly direction for 62m

- The restriction will not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the said works or used for fire brigade, ambulance, or purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the discretion of a Police Constable in uniform.
- The restrictions referred to in paragraphs (1) above will not apply so as to prevent vehicles gaining ingress to, or egress from the premises on or adjacent to the closed length of road in so far as such ingress or egress is reasonably practicable without undue interference with the execution of the said works.
- The restrictions referred to in paragraph (1) will operate during the times and days mentioned in paragraph (1) and only between the start and finish dates stated in paragraph (5). It may be necessary for vehicles to be relocated at the discretion of either the engineer on site or a Police Constable in uniform.
- The Order will operate on and between the following dates and times or until the work has been completed whichever is sooner
