(AMENDMENT NO. 20) ORDER 2007**

**THE HACKNEY (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2007**

TRO 261 AND TRO 262

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 21st September 2007 the Council of the London Borough of Hackney made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Orders will be to: -
 - (a) Formalise existing waiting restrictions operating “at any time” on certain sections of Clapton Common, Gore Road, Lauriston Road and Morpeth Road.
 - (b) Formalise existing “school keep clear” markings operating from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday inclusive on a certain section of Clapton Common.
 - (c) Introduce new waiting restrictions operating “at any time” on certain sections of Amhurst Park, Collent Street, Cranwich Road, Ferron Street and Retreat Place.
3. Copies of the Order, which comes into force on 26th September 2007 and of other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the expiration of a period of six weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, in the reception area, 263 Mare Street, London Borough of Hackney, London, E8 3HT. 4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court
