NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Hackney, in accordance with the Section 90C of the Highway Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1996, proposes the provision of raised speed tables into sections of Chalgrove Road (Trelawney Estate) as listed in schedule 1 and speed humps into sections of Paragon Road as detailed in Schedule 2 attached to this notice.

SCHEDULE 1 – Raised Tables

Raised Speed Table: with a build-out on Paragon Road .The raised speed tables will be constructed and maintained with a maximum height of 100 millimetres, varying length and varying width and on/off gradients of 1:15.

Road	Description
Chalgrove Road	Table 1. From the north-eastern kerbline of Chalgrove Road (Trelawney Estate – Entrance and junction with Paragon Road) is the start of the raised speed table
Chalgrove Road	Table 2. From the north-eastern kerbline of Chalgrove Road (Trelawney Estate – Entrance) eastwards for a distance 47.5 metres is the start of the raised speed table..

SCHEDULE 2 – Speed Humps

Speed Humps: The centre line of the speed hump will be located on Paragon Road

Road	Description
Paragon Road	Hump 1. Between the boundary wall of numbers 70 and 72 Paragon Road
Paragon Road	Hump 2. Between the boundary wall of Hackney Free School and number 54 Paragon Road
Paragon Road	Hump 3. From the north-eastern kerblines of Valette Street, eastwards for a distance of 33.7 metres is the start of the hump
