Your Controlled Parking Zone is Changing

Summary results of Zone J Consultation

Why have you received this booklet?

This leaflet provides a summary of the changes to your Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) that will happen as a result of the recent Zone J review.

The review is designed to ensure that the CPZ is meeting the needs of the local community. We aim to review every new CPZ after its first year of operation and every three years thereafter, as outlined in the Council's Parking and Enforcement Plan (2005).

Consultation Responses

The public consultation for this review took place over 10 weeks from 21 January to 28 March 2008. The majority of feedback came in the form of completed questionnaires, but we also received comments through letters, telephone calls, door-to-door surveys and our public drop-in sessions. Overall, we received an 8% response rate.

We would like to thank all those who took part in the consultation. Your feedback has played a vital part in developing the changes that are going to be made in your area.

Your comments about customer satisfaction are also very important and will help us shape how we deliver our services in the future. With limited amount of kerb side space and competing demands for the available spaces, every effort has been made to balance the needs of all service users.

Controlled Parking Zone J (Queensbridge)

Controlled Parking Zone J is bordered by Richmond Road in the north and Regents Canal in the south. As well as providing a valuable service to local residents and businesses, CPZ J also serves a wide range of people visiting local attractions such as London Fields, Broadway Market and nearby Hackney Central.

The Council is committed to providing a safe environment for the many people that park within the boundary of the CPZ, while ensuring the needs of all road users are carefully balanced.

Summary of design changes to your CPZ

As result of your feedback, we have considered the following design changes to your CPZ:

- Support was received for the current operational hours to remain **Monday to Friday 8:30am – 6:30pm.** (86% in favour of Mon-Fri and 72% in favour of existing 8.30am start time and 61% in favour of a 6.30pm finish time.)
- An improved reallocation of parking bays to reflect how they are currently used – see the tables at the back of this booklet.
- Increased pay and display spaces to provide additional visitor parking for local businesses and visitors to areas such as Broadway Market.
- Improvements in road safety by installing double yellow lines (no waiting at anytime restrictions) in narrow roads and on all junctions.
- The installation of new parking bays where it is safe to do so.
- Feedback received showed support for the proposed installation of double yellow lines over private dropped kerbs - providing 24 hour access to private property.

CPZ Design Criteria

All design changes have been made in line with the Council's design criteria, which outlines standards for the safe installation of parking restrictions in accordance with Department for Transport regulations.

Consideration for the safety of your CPZ has also been made in close consultation with the Emergency Services and the Council's Road Safety team.

Making the Roads Safer

To improve the safety of your CPZ and bring the parking restrictions in line with current safety standards, double yellow lines (no waiting at any time restrictions) will be installed in narrow streets where parked vehicles would cause an obstruction for emergency vehicles.

While we appreciate some single yellow lines will be reduced, every effort has been made to minimise the affects on local users and provide additional dedicated parking bays where possible.

- Double yellow lines will be installed on narrow roads to improve the safe passage of emergency service vehicles, visibility for motorists and pedestrians and traffic flow.
- Double yellow lines to be installed in heavily congested areas and priority bus routes to reduce obstructions and aid traffic flow. For example along sections of Lansdowne Drive to improve access along this busy bus route.
- Double yellow lines will also be installed on all junctions to prevent unsafe parking and to ensure that visibility and access is maintained at all times.

The London Borough of Hackney is committed to providing a safe environment for all road users. We are unable to consider further amendments to the agreed installation of double yellow lines where road safety may be compromised; however we will continue to review the design changes where necessary.

Removal of parking bays

- In some cases it will be necessary to remove some parking spaces from streets which are very narrow and do not allow for the safe clearance of emergency services vehicles. (For more information on the bay removals please contact Parking Services on: 0208 356 8877).

Changes in bay allocation

We also asked for your views on a number of proposed changes in bay allocation so that more spaces are available to residents, short-term visitors and businesses where they are needed. The following changes will soon be made as a result of your feedback:

Street	Parking bay allocation changes
Albion Drive	The 'resident' bay outside 1 to 40 Shoreditch Court will change to a 'disabled' bay.
Albion Drive	The 'resident' bays close to the junction with Queensbridge Road will change to 'shared use'.
Arbutus Street	A section of the 'shared use' bay outside number 6 to 16 will change to a 'loading' bay.
Arbutus Street	The remaining section of the 'shared use' bay outside number 6 to 16 will change to a 'permit' bay.
Benjamin Close	The 'pay and display' bay on the northern side of the road will be changing to a 'doctors' bay.
Benjamin Close	The 'pay and display' bay on the southern side of the road will change to a 'permit' bay.
Broadway Market	The 'doctors' bay outside number 38 to 44 will change to 'shared use'.
Broadway Market	The 'doctors' bay outside number 23 to 31 will change to 'shared use'.
Broadway Market	The 'pay and display' bay outside number 3 to 7 will change to 'shared use'.
Dunston Road	The 'resident' bays outside and opposite of 21 to 37 will change to 'permit' bays.
Dunston Street	The 'permit' bay to the side of 258 Kingsland Road will change to 'shared use'.
Dunston Street	The 'permit' bay outside number 2 will change to 'pay and display'.
Dunston Street	The 'permit' bay outside number 6 to 10 will change to a 'motorcycle' bay.
Frederick Terrace	The 'shared use' bays will change to 'permit' bays.

Street	Parking bay allocation changes
Haggerston Road	The 'resident' bay outside of the park will be changing to 'shared use' (permit holders and pay and display).
Mapledene Road	The 'resident' bay close to the junction with Lansdowne Drive will change to 'shared use'.
Regents Row	The 'resident' bay close to the junction with Broadway Market will change to 'shared use'
Shrubland Road	The 'resident' bays close to the junction with Lansdowne Drive will be changing to 'shared use'.
Welshpool Street	The 'resident' bay will be changing to a 'shared use' bay.
Westgate Street	The 'resident' bay outside of London Fields Primary School will change to a 'permit' bay.

Additional Parking Spaces

Where possible we try to offset any loss of parking bays with additional parking spaces. We will soon be installing a number of new parking bays within the CPZ where the road is wide and safe enough to do so.

Street	New parking bays
Beehive Close	Install a 'resident' bay outside number 4c
Brownlow Road	Install three 'resident' bay spaces at the eastern end of the road
Lee Street	Install a 'pay and display' bay to the side of 290a Kingland Road
Marlborough Avenue	Install a new 'resident' bay south of the junction with Brownlow Road
Middleton Road	Install a 'resident' bay on the eastern boundary of number 19.
Pownall Road	Install a 'resident' bay outside number 15 to 21
Queensbridge Road	Install a 'permit' bay to the side of number 212

Key Implementation Dates

Subject to weather conditions, we plan to:

- Start the sign and lining works in **November 2008**
- Commence enforcement of the new changes in **December 2008**

Consultation on the proposed introduction of parking controls in the London Fields Area

In conjunction with the Zone J review, Parking Services also consulted all residents and businesses in the uncontrolled streets surrounding London Fields Train Station about the proposed introduction of parking controls in the area. The consultation was held due to continuing requests for parking controls from local people and the increasing pressure for parking spaces in the uncontrolled streets.

In total we received a 27% response to the consultation with an overall 66% support for the proposed introduction of parking controls in this area. Based on this feedback, the Council will be proceeding with extending the existing Zone J boundary to include the London Fields area.

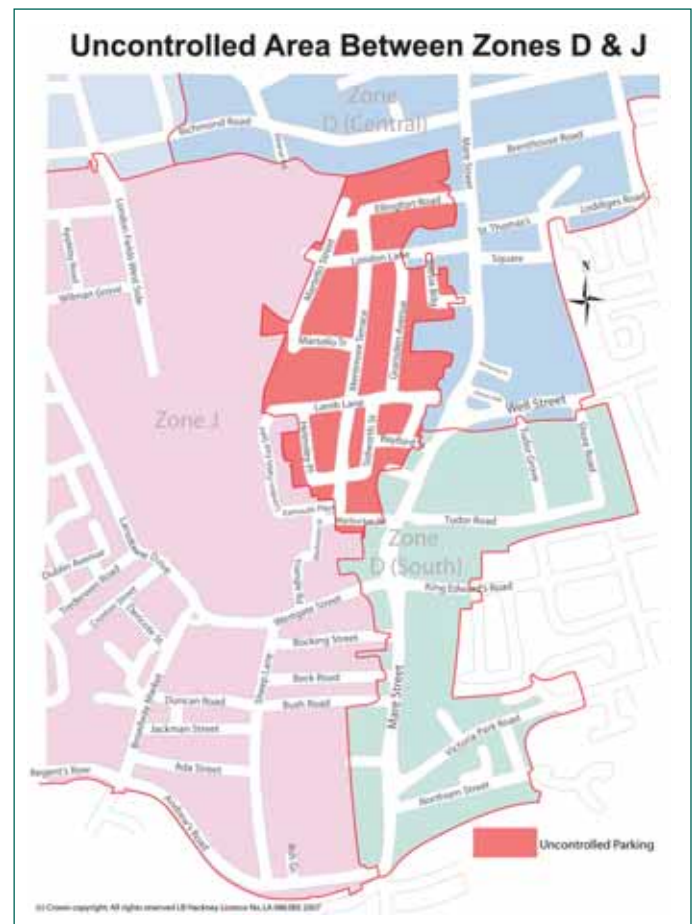
When will implementation of controls commence?

Parking Services will be producing a detailed plan of the parking restrictions in the uncontrolled area and will consult on the proposed design with the residents and businesses in July/August 2009, where they will have the opportunity to have their say on the proposed design of parking restrictions including the location and type of parking bays.

During the consultation stage, residents and businesses within Zone J will also receive a letter informing them of the consultation. Information relating to the consultation will also be available on the Council's website www.hackney.gov.uk/parking.

Key Dates

Stage 2 design consultation with residents and businesses in the uncontrolled area will commence in **July/August 2009**.



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

How do my views influence the design of the CPZ?

Public feedback helps us identify the needs and preferences of all service users so that we can develop a balanced CPZ with parking space allocated accordingly. Although limited by a finite amount of kerb space, we aim to meet demand by reallocating bays and installing new bays where possible. This is why it is so important that you provide us with your feedback during reviews.

Do you consider road safety?

We work closely with the Emergency Services and the Traffic and Highways Departments to determine safety considerations for your CPZ. We plan to install double yellow lines ('no waiting at any time' restrictions) at most junctions to improve road safety for both pedestrians and motorists. In some cases, we might shorten or remove bays if they obstruct traffic flow in your CPZ.

Will we be notified before the changes come into effect?

The Council will notify all affected residents and businesses well in advance of making any changes to parking bays. You can see our planned date for starting works on page 5 of this leaflet. A reminder letter explaining the pending changes and detailing our implementation timetable will be sent to you nearer the time.

Do you monitor if the CPZ changes are effective?

We carry out an interim review of the CPZ once every three years. We also welcome feedback about the changes at anytime.

New 'greener' permit prices

Parking permits are now priced according to the size of your vehicle's engine and the fuel it uses. These factors relate to the volume of gases emitted by your vehicle that have an impact on the local and global environment.

If your car has an engine which is more environmentally friendly (under 1200cc) or partly runs on greener fuel then it will be eligible for a 50% discount on the standard price of a parking permit. If you own an electric car or another vehicle that runs solely on greener fuel you can apply for a FREE permit.

Your annual residents parking permit will be priced accordingly:

Greener fuels & smaller engines (under 1200cc)	£43.50	£24.50	£13.50
Normal engine size (1200 to 2000cc)	£87.00	£49.00	£27.00

Very larger engine size (3001 to 4000cc)	£174.00	£98.00	£54.00
Extremely large engine size (4001 plus cc)	£217.50	£122.50	£67.50

Cessation of clamping

The clamping and removal policies have been revised as of 1 July 2007.

In most instances we will cease to clamp, or remove, your vehicle if you are parked in an authorised parking space. However there will be number of exceptions such as:

- Parking in a disabled bay without a valid Blue or Companion Badge.
- Footway parking (dropped kerbs and pavements)
- Parking on single or double yellow lines during set hours
- Where the parked vehicle is obstructing traffic
- Persistent evaders of parking fines
