- a body representing persons involved in such business e.g. a trade association

Responsible authorities and interested parties or their representatives, may make representations on licensing objective grounds only. The licensing objectives are:

- the prevention of crime and disorder
- the prevention of public nuisance
- public safety
- the protection of children from harm
