Hackney Core Strategy Development Plan Document

This adoption statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulations 24(4) and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, and gives notice that the London Borough of Hackney adopted its

Core Strategy Development Plan Document (DPD) on 24 November 2010

The Core Strategy DPD forms part of the Hackney Local Development Framework (LDF) which will replace, in part, the Hackney Unitary Development Plan 1995. The LDF forms the basis for decisions on land use and spatial planning affecting Hackney for the period until 2025, and will comprise a number of DPDs.

The Core Strategy sets out the spatial structure of the Borough, and seeks to support and deliver the overall vision and objectives for the Borough as established in the Sustainable Community Strategy and other similar related documents. The Core Strategy DPD covers the whole Borough area and is the first such DPD to be adopted by the Council.

The Core Strategy was considered by independent Inspector, Mr Michael J Hetherington BSC(Hons) MA MRTPI, at an Examination in Public held between 20 to 28 July 2010. The Inspector found the Core Strategy to be sound subject to a number of changes - all changes being based on changes put forward by Hackney Council in response to points raised and suggestions discussed during the public examination.

The Inspector's Report, with its recommendations, was published on 27 September 2010. The adopted Core Strategy incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. Any challenge must be made on the grounds that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than **6 weeks after the date** on which the Core Strategy was adopted, i.e 6 January 2011.
