# Introduction

This profile explores the demographic, social and economic characteristics of Clissold Ward and is largely based on data drawn from the 2011 Census. The ward profiles should be a helpful resource for local people and services that want a basic overview of the key characteristics and make up of local wards.

In 2014 new ward boundaries were introduced in Hackney. This means that it is not possible to directly source data from the 2011 Census for this ward. The Census data contained in this profile for the ward is built up from smaller geographies, and uses a 'best fit' methodology<sup>1</sup>. This profile is a snapshot, and is intended to support an understanding of Hackney's ward characteristics and support local decision making.

All data used in this profile has been drawn from the 2011 Census unless otherwise stated. More ward-level statistics can be found at the GLA Datstore [Ward Profiles](#) pages. 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<sup>1</sup> It should also be noted that there may be some anomalies in the new data due to rounding. Additionally, if ONS do at some point update Census data according to new Ward boundaries, the data that would be released would differ slightly from that in this profile. This is because ONS would re-analyse the Census data to aggregate exactly to new Ward boundaries, rather than use 'best fit' methods.

## Key characteristics

Clissold Ward lies on the North-Western side of Hackney. At the time of the 2011 Census it was home to 13,141 people. The ward contains Clissold Park.

The profile shows that Clissold's population has a relatively large proportion of adults aged 30-64 and fewer children and young adults under 30 than Hackney. It has proportionately more white British and fewer black African and Caribbean people than the Hackney average. The ward has proportionally more couples, with and without children, but fewer lone parent and single person households than Hackney as a whole.

Clissold's economic and social profiles show that over half of adults living in Clissold ward have degree-level qualifications or higher, and unemployment is lower than the Hackney average. Over two thirds of the working-age population in Clissold is in work, in 2001 this was 60%.

Residents of Clissold Ward enjoy generally better health than in Hackney as a whole.

Hackney has a greater proportion of children under seven years than London or England and Wales, around the same proportion of children 8-15, and fewer young people aged 15-19.

It has a particularly large cohort of 20-44 year olds, and fewer people aged 45 and over.

Clissold has a greater proportion of adults aged 30-64 and fewer children and young adults under 30 than Hackney.

Hackney is one of the most ethnically diverse boroughs in the country – just over 40% of its people are non-White.

Black groups make up the largest component of the minority communities, accounting for almost a quarter of Hackney's residents, followed by the White Other group, which can include East and West Europeans, North and South Americans, White Africans and Antipodeans.

Clissold has proportionally more white British residents and fewer black African and Caribbean residents than Hackney as a whole.

Less than half of Hackney's residents describe themselves as Christians – a significantly smaller proportion than in London or England. The borough has relatively high proportions of people of the Jewish and Muslim faiths and people with no religion or who declined to state one.

There are proportionally more residents stating no religion and fewer people of the Jewish, Muslim and Christian faiths in Clissold than the borough average.

Hackney has proportionately more lone parent, single person and multi person households than the averages for both London and England, and fewer married couple households (both with and without children).

Clissold has proportionally fewer single person and lone parent households, but more couples with and without children than the Hackney average.

Nearly half of Hackney's housing is socially rented, a much higher percentage than in London or nationally. Home ownership is correspondingly lower – less than a quarter of the borough's households are owner occupiers. Nearly a third of Hackney's households rent their homes from a private landlord.

Clissold Ward has proportionally more home owners and fewer social and private renters than the borough average.

London's qualifications profile tends to differ from the national picture. It has a better-educated population, with 37.7% of people having at least a first degree (level 4/5). It also has below average rates of residents with level 1 or 2 qualifications (to GCSE level), and lower rates of residents with no qualifications, too.

These trends are even more pronounced in Hackney. Over 40% of residents have degree-level qualifications. The proportion with no qualifications in Hackney is higher than the London average, but lower than the England average. Hackney has relatively few adults with mid-level qualifications.

Clissold's profile is skewed toward the upper end of the skills range, with over half of adults holding degree-level qualifications or higher and fewer adults with no, or level 1, 2 or 3 qualifications than the Hackney average.

Economic activity rates in Hackney are now about the same as in London or England.

Employment levels are higher in Clissold for full time workers and the self employed than the Hackney average. Unemployment and economic inactivity are correspondingly lower.

London's profile is strongly skewed towards managerial, professional and administrative occupations with smaller proportions than nationally of skilled trades people; process plant and machine operatives; and those in personal or customer service occupations.

Hackney differs somewhat from the London pattern. It has more professionals and associates and fewer managers. It also has a slightly higher percentage of those in elementary occupations.

Clissold's profile shows a greater proportion of workers in managerial, professional and technical roles and fewer administrators, elementary and service sector employees than the borough average.

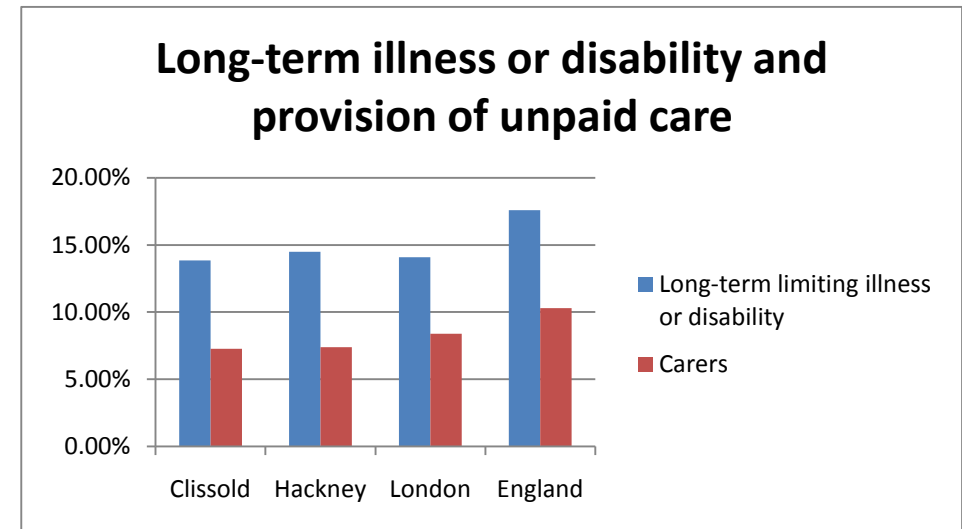

The health of Hackney's residents is broadly in line with national trends. It should be noted though that the borough has a young population by England standards.

Clissold's residents generally enjoy slightly better health than Hackney overall.

The proportion of Clissold residents who say they have a long-term limiting illness or disability is lower than the Hackney or London averages.

The proportion of residents providing unpaid care in Clissold Ward is about the same as the Hackney average.

# Deprivation

The Index of Multiple Deprivation gauges the level of deprivation in a locality across several 'domains', including employment, income, health, education and crime.

England is divided into over 32,800 Lower Super Output Areas (LSOA's). These are areas containing around 1,500 people and 650 households.

Since the 2014 ward boundary changes Lower Super Output Areas no longer match ward boundaries exactly. The map opposite illustrates the parts of the ward which experience the greatest deprivation. The areas shaded in red and dark orange lie in the 20% most deprived Lower Super Output Areas in England and the light orange and yellow areas are in the 30% most deprived LSOA's and above.

The south-eastern tip of Clissold Ward experiences higher levels of deprivation than elsewhere.

According to a calculation prepared by the Local Government Association, Clissold is the least deprived ward in Hackney, ranking 21<sup>st</sup> out of 21 wards, it is within the 40% most deprived wards in London, ranking 233 out of 654 wards, and is just outside the top 20% of English wards in terms of deprivation.<sup>2</sup>

Clissold lies in the parliamentary constituency of Hackney North and Stoke Newington. This was won in 2015 by Dianne Abbott (Labour) with a majority of 18,350, winning 62.9% of the votes cast on a 56.8% turn out for the constituency overall.
