CIVIC AMENITIES ACT 1967
DE BEAUVOIR TOWN CONSERVATION AREA

SUMMARY

1. This report recommends that following consultations with the Greater London Council and the London Borough of Islington, part of De Beauvoir Town be designated as a Conservation Area.
2. The Committee on 29th September, 1970 authorised the statutory consultations with the Greater London Council and the London Borough of Islington before designating the area as a Conservation Area.

GREATER LONDON COUNCIL

3. The Architect to the Greater London Council considers that the requirements of Part I, Section I of the Civic Amenities Act 1967 have been met and that he is pleased to note that the Council intend to proceed with the designation.

LONDON BOROUGH OF ISLINGTON

4. The Islington Borough Planning Officer has replied that he has no observations and will report to his Conservation Areas Advisory Committee.

RECOMMENDATION - That the area shown coloured pink on Drawing No. 14/89 be designated a Conservation Area for the purpose of Section I of the Civic Amenities Act 1967.
